After the destruction of the Temple, the mikvehs main uses remained as follows: by Jewish women to achieve ritual purity after menstruation or childbirth A cistern filled by the rain is also permitted to act as a mikvehs water supply. 1 Nov 2014 . A mikvah is a pool of water — some of it from a natural source — in which observant married Jewish women are required to dip once a month, seven days after the end of their menstrual cycle.
